LESSON 1

i “For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.” – Leviticus 17:11

Have you ever given blood? I’m sure some have – some haven’t – but the message will still be clear. The purpose is to provide help for another. The blood you give is then broken down into its many parts and used to help as many as three (3) people. After one gives, they are asked to rest, and the giver may feel tired. Some even experience dizziness. The reason? The source of life has been removed from you. Enough remains to sustain you and your body will replace what has been taken but it will take time. Thus, the life of the flesh, your body, is in the blood.
