LESSON 2 – PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION

i "And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him." - Leviticus 1:4

"So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation." -Hebrews 9:28

Identification: Our relationship with Christ is a personal thing! It's not based on church membership and not based on our family name. It's based on whether we identify with Christ and we do that by placing our faith and trust in Him and identifying with Him through our sin and our sin nature. We have to admit ourselves a sinner and then admit our sin. The placing of the hand on the head of the offering identifies the sinner with the "sin-offering" now accepts the sin and makes atonement for the sin. The very start of the Levitical system pictures Christ identifying with our sin and our sin nature and accepting the toll and making atonement but doing so once and for all!

Key Terms and Thoughts

Atonement	"And he shall put his hand upon the head of the burnt offering; and it shall be accepted for him to make atonement for him" – Leviticus 1:4 - Too Many to List – Leviticus start to Finish!
Sacrifice	"If his offering be a burnt sacrifice of the herd, let him offer a male without blemish: he shall offer it of his own voluntary will at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation before the Lord." Leviticus 1:3 Too Many to List – Leviticus start to Finish!
Offering	"Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, If any man of you bring an offering unto the Lord, ye shall bring your offering of the cattle, even of the herd, and of the flock." – Leviticus 1:2 Too Many to List – Leviticus start to Finish!
Burnt Offering	Shows Christ offering Himself <u>without spot</u> to God to do His Father's will even in death. – it was totally consumed in fire and was a <u>free will</u> offering. It was also called a " <u>sweet savour</u> " offering – pleasing to the Father.
