LESSON 3 – THE MEAL OFFERING/ “THE BREAD OF LIFE”

i “And when any will offer a meat offering unto the Lord, his offering shall be of fine flour; and he shall pour oil upon it, and put frankincense thereon.” – Leviticus 2:1

“Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven.” – John 6:32

The first three offerings are called “sweet savour” offerings and are brought to the Lord in worship and praise and not in asking for forgiveness of sin. We are approaching God in church in worship and praise! Yes, we need forgiveness but we also need to simply present ourselves a living sacrifice, giving of ourselves; the meal/meat offering is just that – a giving of ourselves to God. This in turn represents Christ giving of Himself completely to save our souls and to satisfies the Father.

Key Terms and Thoughts

Savour	Aroma, fragrance, smell, - most all the time appears in reference to something presented to God.
Frankincense	An aromatic resin from the Boswellia tree used to make and oil and then used to make incense.
Oblation	A gift or act of giving
Leaven	a substance, typically yeast, that is used in dough to make it rise.
