LESSON 10 – THE FEASTS TRUMPETS

²³And the Lord spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, In the seventh month, in the first day of the month, shall ye have a sabbath, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, an holy convocation. Ye shall do no servile work therein: but ye shall offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord." – Leviticus 23:23-25

"For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord." – I Thessalonians 4:16-17

If you have read and studied the Bible for any length of time, the sounding of a trumpet is familiar to you. God's "call" to His people is always noticeable and audible and one of action and usually of an immediate nature. These final three feasts all represent the call of the nation of Israel back to their homeland and to their God! The Feast of Pentecost brought the Holy Spirit on the scene (figuratively for the church) and the Feasts of Trumpets is now the current Church Age as we wait for the Trumpet to sound call into existence the tribulation period and the shout to call the church home...

Seven (7) Feasts

Passover	This is representative of the shed blood of Jesus
Unleavened Bread	This is representative of the sinless life of Jesus and need for the repentance of sin of the sinner
First Fruits	This representative of the resurrection of Jesus from the dead – the first from the dead
Weeks (Pentecost)	This represents the arrival and presence of the Holy Spirit
Trumpets	This represents the current Church age
Atonement	The Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary
Tabernacles	The Millennial Reign of Christ
