### LESSON 11 – THE FEAST OF ATONEMENT

**i** “And the Lord spake unto Moses, saying, Also on the tenth day of this seventh month there shall be a day of atonement: it shall be an holy convocation unto you; and ye shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire unto the Lord.” – Leviticus 23:26-27

“And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the **atonement**.” – Romans 5:11

“But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; Neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us.” – Hebrews 9:11-12

Leviticus 16 and the entire book of Hebrews go hand in hand with the works of Christ and the “atonement” of our sin. But, in contrast to the atonement or “covering” of our sin in the ways of the Old Testament rituals and were repeated year after year by the high priest, Christ, by His blood, did more than cover – He completely paid the debt once and for all. Hebrews explains the difference between the blood of animals and the incomplete work of the high priest and the finished and total work of the Calvary and Christ.

#### Seven (7) Feasts

Passover	This is representative of the shed blood of Jesus
Unleavened Bread	This is representative of the sinless life of Jesus and need for the repentance of sin of the sinner
First Fruits	This representative of the resurrection of Jesus from the dead – the first from the dead
Weeks (Pentecost)	This represents the arrival and presence of the Holy Spirit
Trumpets	This represents the current Church age
<b>Atonement</b>	<b>The Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary</b>
Tabernacles	The Millennial Reign of Christ
