## LESSON 9 – THE FEASTS WEEKS (PENTECOST)

**i** "Even unto the morrow after the seventh sabbath shall ye number fifty days; and ye shall offer a new meat offering unto the Lord." – Leviticus 23:16

*And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.* – Acts 2:1

Leviticus 23:17 speaks of 2 loaves – no sheafs this time. The work of the Holy Spirit in the New Testament, after the resurrection of Christ, is to indwell the believer. The believer is now a joining of both Jew and Gentile; it's not longer just about Israel. It's about the Church that is now being gathering and built under the power and influence of the teachings of the Holy Spirit. The two loaves could very well represent the joining of both Jew and Gentile and the baking of those loaves required the beating of the wheat into flour and then the heat of the oven to bake the flour into bread. The church is experiencing the "beating" and the "heat" of the persecution of the world today.

### Seven (7) Feasts

Passover	This is representative of the shed blood of Jesus
Unleavened Bread	This is representative of the sinless life of Jesus and need for the repentance of sin of the sinner
First Fruits	This representative of the resurrection of Jesus from the dead – the first from the dead
<b>Weeks (Pentecost)</b>	<b>This represents the arrival and presence of the Holy Spirit</b>
Trumpets	This represents the current Church age
Atonement	The Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary
Tabernacles	The Millennial Reign of Christ
