LESSON 12 – THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES

i "Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be the feast of tabernacles for seven days unto the Lord." – Leviticus 23:33

"In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water." – John 7:37-38

"And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God." – Revelation 21:3

A time of remembrance. Just as the Christian and the church today take time during the Lord's Supper/Communion to remember the sacrifice of Christ and our deliverance from our sins and our sin nature, the nation of Israel remembered their deliverance from the oppression of Egypt and their protection in the wilderness. The Feast of Tents/Booths/Sukkoth, etc. commemorates final deliverance and prophetically pictures the ultimate gathering of the church and the reign of Christ following the terrible time of the Great Tribulation period when Israel will come to the realization of Christ as King. The "New Beginnings" for everyone and the final dwelling place of God with man will be established for eternity.

Seven (7) Feasts

Passover	This is representative of the shed blood of Jesus
Unleavened Bread	This is representative of the sinless life of Jesus and need for the repentance of sin of the sinner
First Fruits	This representative of the resurrection of Jesus from the dead – the first from the dead
Weeks (Pentecost)	This represents the arrival and presence of the Holy Spirit
Trumpets	This represents the current Church age
Atonement	The Sacrifice of Christ on Calvary
Tabernacles	The Millennial Reign of Christ
